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**ATTACHMENT 8 TO APPLICATION AND SUPPORTING DECLARATION**

As stated below, my husband has moved out of the family house and is residing in an apartment. I am a stay-at-home mom, caring for our one-year-old daughter and four-year-old son. Our son has been having emotional problems, and needs my care and possibly some professional therapy. I do not work, and have no immediate ability to work out of the home.

Respondent has taken away my access to community-property bank accounts. He is threatening to go to Afghanistan for an extended stay, and I therefore need a support order immediately to be able to survive.

I requested a TRO last week, and the court denied it—not even a “stay away” order. I have no idea why that was denied, since Respondent is out of the house and is threatening to go to Afghanistan. Because the TRO was denied, I cannot get a hearing for temporary orders until September 15, three months away. I need a hearing immediately, and I respectfully request the court grant me an Order Shortening Time.

**ATTACHMENT 10 TO APPLICATION AND SUPPORTING DECLARATION**

Respondent KAMAL S. HASHIMI has moved out of the family residence at 3018 Chickpea Ct. in Antioch, and into an apartment, effective 1/15/05. He works late as the general manager of a car dealership in Richmond, CA, and frequently spends additional late hours socializing. He often returns home at 2 am, or as late as 4 am. Our son Akbar has been having trouble with acting out, and I believe this is either caused by or exacerbated by Respondent’s refusal to act as a responsible parent. I specifically asked Respondent if he would change his habits and become more of a parent, and he categorically said “No”. I request he be ordered to attend Parenting classes.

Respondent has announced that he wants to go to Afghanistan (his native country until age 6) for a month or more, supposedly for investment purposes. I have no idea why he really wants to do this, but I greatly fear that he may return to the family residence and remove personal property without my knowledge or permission unless he is restrained from staying away from the home.

Respondent receives a base salary as the general manager of a car dealership, and he also gets paid under the table. He has taken complete control over our family finances and cut me off from all support except what he feels like giving me. I request he be ordered to report all his earnings, including moneys not reported to the taxing

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authorities, and that he be ordered to complete disclosure pleadings with required attachments within 30 days.

I have not worked out of the home for several years, except for a short amount of time last year. I am the primary caretaker for our one-year-old child, Sophyia E. Hashimi, and our four-year-old son Akbar. It is a financial and physical impossibility for me to work for the foreseeable future. Respondent has an excellent income, and I ask for the guideline levels of support pending the trial of this matter.

I have had to advance \$3,000 to retain my attorney, and I ask that Respondent be ordered to reimburse me that sum.





4. crear una transferencia no incluida en el procedimiento sucesorio o modificar una transferencia no incluida en el procedimiento sucesorio de manera tal que afecte la disposición de los bienes sujetos a la transferencia, sin el consentimiento por escrito de la otra parte o una orden del tribunal. Antes de que la revocación de una transferencia no incluida en el procedimiento sucesorio pueda entrar en vigor, o de que el derecho de supervivencia a los bienes se pueda eliminar, se debe presentar un aviso del cambio al tribunal, y dicho aviso se debe entregar a la otra parte.


